If a student enters the Ph.D. program with a master's degree from another institution, some coursework may be waived, pending a review of the transcript and the syllabus and approval by the Counseling Psychology program faculty. The Graduate School limits the total number of credits to be waived to 30. After a review of the student's petition for waiving courses by the program faculty, the student's academic advisor and doctoral committee members can recommend that a specific number of hours in a master's degree be transferred toward the total hours required for the doctoral degree.
